- Write about it, including the following three components:
  - *Explain* (in B822 and practical terms) why you chose that particular problem and those particular techniques (rather than others).
  - *Describe* what took place during your practical work, focussing critically on process issues (i.e. not just giving the output) and using B822 concepts.
  - *Reflect* on the whole experience (again, drawing on Block 2 sources), commenting on what took place (how, why, etc.) and how you might do it differently next time.
